

## Main Street Development 2019 Update

Welcome to 2019!

Thank you to the Bourke community for your patience during these summer months with work to the main street held over while this hot summer continues. With temperatures on the bitumen at over 50 degrees it has proven too hot to continue in January and February, works have now commenced again.

Just before Christmas the eastern road crossing was poured and two shade structures installed to the western end of Oxley Street. These shade structures start to give the main street an additional dimension and the final layout is starting to take shape.

Once work crews return, the final touches to the Court House end of the street will be made and then works to the middle of the street will be underway.

Since Christmas, the main street work team have largely been undertaking scheduled works to the Back O' Bourke Exhibition Centre. Refurbishing the café area to now be a Conference facility and making the rest of the facility ready for the upcoming tourist season.

Now work has commenced in the main street further updates of upcoming works will continue.
