### INTRODUCTION OF WATER LEVEL FOUR (4) RESTRICTIONS FOR THE TOWN OF BOURKE AND NORTH BOURKE

Bourke Shire Council advises all residents of Bourke and North Bourke that due to the ongoing depletion of the Bourke Weir Pool, Level Four (4) Water Restrictions will apply effective mid-day Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> October 2019.

The height of the Darling River at Bourke Weir has dropped to drop below to 2.5 metres and this is the catalyst for the introduction of level four (4) water restrictions.

The use of fixed sprinklers continues to be prohibited.

Hand held hoses can now only be used for one (1) hour per day only at each property.

These restrictions apply to both filtered and raw water supplies.

The washing of paved areas and motor vehicles can only be undertaken using buckets (commercial operations with recycling facilities are exempt) and the filling or topping up of private swimming pools is prohibited in accordance with Council's adopted policy.

The cooperation of all residents is sought in complying with these restrictions.

Level five (5) water restrictions will come into consideration when the level in the weir pool drops to 2.00 metres.

There are a number of variables to be considered when trying to predict timeframes of this nature with the possibility of a substantial rain event one of these variables.

Water restrictions as detailed in Council's adopted policy will also apply to watering of public parks, recreational areas and sporting ovals.

While water consumption for domestic (household) use is not subject to change residents are still requested to be mindful to take measures to reduce consumption like ensuring that the taps don't continue to run whilst cleaning your teeth.

### **Appendix 1 of Drought Management Plan**

#### **Water Restrictions for Public Parks and Sporting Grounds in Bourke**

**These hours / watering conditions apply during level 1, 2, 3 and 4 restrictions only.**

From November 2018 until Level 5 Water Restrictions are activated.

- Davidson Oval - no change to watering
- Central Park - no change to watering
- Coolican Oval - no change to watering
- Swimming Pool Complex – no change to watering

During restrictions the park and sporting ovals below will be able to water during all hours Monday to Friday to maintain current standards. (16hrs each weekly total)

- Tourist centre- watering of lawns as per restrictions.
- Cemetery- watering of lawns as per restrictions.
- Airport Gardens-gardens only
- Wal Mitchell Wharf Precinct - watering of, Crossley Engine section and entrance area to wharf only as per restrictions.
- Jones Park- watering of lawns as per restrictions.
- North Bourke Oval - no watering.
- Percy Hobson Park - watering of lawns as per restrictions.
- Port of Bourke Park- watering of lawns as per restrictions.

During restrictions the parks, recreational areas and sporting ovals below will be able to water during the hours of 7.30am to 4.30pm (10 hrs each weekly total)

- Bourke Bowling (BBC) Club greens and gardens -During restrictions the BBC will be able to water during the hours of 8.30am to 10.30am two (2hrs) Monday through Friday only. (10hrs weekly total)
- Golf Club-During restrictions the Golf Club will be able to water during the hours of 6.00pm to 8.00am Monday through Friday for shrubs and trees only
- Rotary Park-During restrictions the park will be able to water during the hours of 6.00am to 8.00pm  
Monday through Friday for a period of two (2) hrs a day only. (10 hrs weekly total)
- Back O' Bourke Exhibition Centre- During water restrictions the BOB centre will be able to water during the hours of 8.00am until 1.00pm five (5hrs) on Tuesdays and Fridays only. (10hrs total weekly)
- Bourke High School-During water restrictions the school will be able to water during the hours of 6.30am until 11.30am five (5hrs) on Wednesdays and Thursdays only. (10hrs total weekly)
- Caravan Parks and Motels - During water restrictions the caravan parks and motels will only be able to water two (2) days a week at five (5hrs) per day. (10hrs total weekly).
- Bourke Hospital - During water restrictions the Hospital will only be able to water two (2) days a week at five (5hrs) per day, (10hrs total weekly).

### Appendix 2 of Drought Management Plan

## Water Restrictions for Public Parks and Sporting Grounds in Bourke

### These hours / watering conditions apply during Level 5 restrictions only.

From April 2019 until Level 6 Water Restrictions are activated.

- Davidson Oval – Five (5) hours three (3) times a week
- Central Park – Five (5) hours three (3) times a week
- Coolican Oval – Two and one half (2.5) hours per week Monday from midnight
- Public and Commercial Gardens – One (1) hour per day handheld hoses only

#### Other areas

- Old Railway Building- No watering.
- Cemetery- Hand watering – permanent planting only
- Airport Gardens-one (1) hour only two (2) days per week permanent plantings only
- Wal Mitchell Wharf Precinct - No watering.
- Jones Park- No watering.
- North Bourke Oval - No watering.
- Percy Hobson Park - No watering.
- Port of Bourke Park- No watering.
  
- Bourke Bowling Club (BBC) greens and gardens -During restrictions the BBC will be able to water one (1) hour per green on a Monday and gardens two (2) hours hand held hoses twice a week
- Golf Club- No watering.
- Rotary Park- No Watering
- Back O' Bourke Exhibition Centre – two (2) hours hand held hoses three (3) days per week permanent planting only
- All Schools- five (5) hours per week only with a reduced area
- Bourke Olympic Pool – five (5) hours per week
- Caravan Parks and Motels – five (5) hours per week
- Hospital – five (5) hours per week
- Commercial Carwash – 90% reuse water only
