DISCOLORATION OF FILTERED WATER SUPPLY

Bourke Shire Council advises that some parts of Bourke and North Bourke could experience a discoloration in the filtered water supply.

Residents are advised that if they notice the discoloration in the water they should allow the tap to run until the water clears

The discoloration is a result of work being undertaken on the water reservoir to remove a sediment built up at the bottom of the reservoir

The water has been treated as normal and the discoloration is a result of the disturbance of the sediment and the entry of that sediment into the reticulation system

The discoloration may take some time to completely clear and residents may experience periodic instances of discoloration and should continue to allow the taps to run until the water clears on each occasion.
