NSW RFS Far West Team Notice of Hazard Reduction Works and Burn Bourke Levee

22 October 2020

The NSW Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) in conjunction with the New South Wales Police, Fire + Rescue NSW and Bourke Shire Council will be conducting hazard reduction activities around the Bourke Levee. This burn is to be conducted on Monday 2nd November 2020 until Friday 9th November 2020 after a number of ignitions in this area over the last week.

NSW RFS Inspector Craig Warwick in conjunction with Inspector Paul Quigg Crime Manager Central North Police District, Station Commander John Milgate F+R NSW and Dwayne Willoughby Manager Environmental Services Bourke Shire Council all agree this hazard reduction works and burning needs to be completed for the benefit of the community of Bourke.

Inspector Warwick confirms that the works in preparation for this burn will start with the State Mitigation Indigenous Works crews from Bourke and Brewarrina starting the control line works on Monday 26th October 2020 which will take a week to prepare as there is works to be done around the River gums so they are not damaged during the hazard reduction burn.

Inspector Warwick said all residents of the Bourke area should take all washing of the line and anyone who suffers from breathing problems are to keep all windows closed during the burn period.
