How to Nominate

- Nominations must be received by **4.30pm, Friday 1st of December 2023**
- Nominees will be assessed based on information provided in the nomination form and/or supporting recommendation letter.

Eligibility

- Nominees must be Australian Citizens and reside in the Bourke Local Government Area.
- Individuals cannot nominate themselves.
- Selection for the awards will be made on the basis of service to the local community in any field considered appropriate by the selection committee and may also take into account acts of compassion, generosity, bravery, etc.

- Contribution by an individual to the Bourke Local Government Area is to be voluntary and may be of general or specific nature. Nominees must not have received a taxable income for their contributions.

Assessment

- Award recipients will be selected at the discretion of the selection committee. If nominations for a particular category are unsuitable, the committee reserves the right not to select an award recipient or consider the nomination under another category.
- The selection committee reserves the right to obtain more information about each person from whatever source appropriate.
